Important notes for examination candidates

- Sitting an examination implies that candidates have read and are familiar with the *Year 12 Information Handbook 2018*. The handbook can be downloaded from <http://www.scsa.wa.edu.au/publications/year-12-information>.
- Candidates must arrive 30 minutes prior to the start time. This will allow time for seating, administrative processes and the reading of instructions.
- All ATAR course examinations are 3 hours working time unless otherwise indicated. ♦ Denotes an examination with 2½ hours working time.
- All ATAR course examinations have 10 minutes reading time unless otherwise indicated.
- Mathematics Applications, Mathematics Methods and Mathematics Specialist examinations consist of two sections.
 - Section one: Calculator-free has 5 minutes reading time and 50 minutes working time.
 - Section two: Calculator-assumed has 10 minutes reading time and 100 minutes working time.
- No allowance can be made to candidates who miss the examination session through misreading the timetable.
- The written examinations timetable is final and no changes will be made.
