Involvement: Encourage and support students to engage in College and Christian Service activities, to live our Catholic ethos.

Engagement: Engage with the Sacred Heart College community by supporting College and P&F Initiatives.

Role Model: Support the College Rules and Behaviour Expectations Policies at all College events and where the College is present, for example sporting events and social gatherings. Display the courage of our convictions by supporting and upholding the College values.

Traffic/Safety: Follow traffic rules and other regulations in and around the College, to ensure safety and the amenity of neighbours, particularly in relation to traffic and noise.
